Bremen Congregation Grieves

It is with extreme sadness that Agape reports the passing of Pastor Sergot.

In early March, he was diagnosed with late stage Pancreatic and Liver cancer. He was given the best medical care possible in Haiti and the prayers of his congregation were with him continually. He is survived by his wife and children.

Pastor Sergot began the church at Bremen when the compound land was secured by the mission. For the next 12 years, he was the lead Pastor for this congregation.

His leadership of the congregation provided an

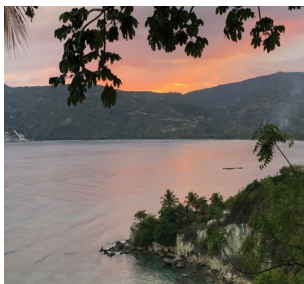
outreach to the community including the distribution of needed food and water. He taught from the pulpit every Sunday morning and lead prayer services on Wednesday and Friday evenings. Many of these prayer services would start in the early evening and last all night.

His Bremen preaching began under the large Mango tree at the entrance to the compound. As the congregation grew and mission teams arrived, an open air pavilion was constructed on the compound where services were held. The pavilion had to be expanded to accommodate the growing

congregation and school. When funds were raised to purchase the supplies needed for the construction of the large Bremen "Hebron" Church, he was the most excited one on the compound. He watched as the months passed and teams got closer to completion of the construction. We even held a service in the new building before the roof was completed. He helped to dedicate the Bremen Church in Feb 2019. He loved preaching in the new church and will always be known as the founding Pastor of Hebron Church.

His memory be always be in our hearts.
